AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA CUARESIMAL

En los Estados Unidos de América, Conferencia de los Obispos Católicos ha declarado que “la edad para ayunar es desde el cumplimiento de los 18 años hasta el comienzo de la edad de 60 años.” La Conferencia (USCCB) permite también la substitución de otra forma de penitencia por la abstinencia en todos los viernes del año, excepto los viernes de la Cuaresma. Por lo tanto, las reglas para el ayuno y la abstinencia para los Estados Unidos son: Cada persona que tiene 14 años o más debe abstenerse de carnes (y comidas hechas con productos de carnes) el **Miércoles de Ceniza**, el **Viernes Santo**, y **todos los viernes de la Cuaresma**. Cada persona entre las edades de 18 y 60 años debe ayunar en el **Miércoles de Ceniza y Viernes Santo**. Todos los que tienen 14 años o más deben abstenerse de carne (y comidas hechas con productos de carnes) en todos los demás viernes del año a menos que el o ella sustituye alguna otra forma de penitencia por abstinencia.

† RULES OF FAST & ABSTINENCE PER CANON LAW:



Abstinence The law of abstinence requires Catholics 14 years of age and over to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent in honor of the Passion of Jesus. Meat is considered to be the flesh and organs of mammals and fowl. Also forbidden are soups or gravies made from them. Salt and freshwater species of fish, amphibians, reptiles and shellfish are permitted, as are animal-derived products such as margarine and gelatin which do not have any meat taste.

Fasting The law of fasting requires Catholics from ages 18 to 59 to reduce the amount of food eaten from normal. The Church defines this as one meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed the main meal in quantity. **Such fasting is obligatory on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.** The fast is broken by eating between meals and by drinks which could be considered food (milk shakes, but not milk).

Who is DISPENSED from fast and abstinence?: Those of unsound mind, the sick, the frail, pregnant or nursing women according to need for meat or nourishment, manual laborers according to need, guests at a meal who cannot excuse themselves without giving great offense or causing enmity, and those in other situations of moral or physical impossibility.
